Vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Apparel including helmets must be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Fuel shall comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. All vehicles shall be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. A valid CAMS Licence, Club Membership card and vehicle logbook (if issued) must be presented at Document Check.
25. **CLASSES:** a) ROAD TYRES
b) RALLY TYRES
c) 4WD SPECIALS
26. **RESULTS:** Results will be determined from the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, plus any penalties.
27. **PRIZES & TROPHIES:** 1ST, 2ND, 3RD OUTFIGHT / 1st in Class – All Classes / 1ST LADY / 1ST, 2ND, 3RD JUNIOR
28. The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
29. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
30. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
31. Entries from Competitors under 18 years of age must be counter-signed /consented to by parent/guardian.
32. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement). Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
33. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
34. The organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
35. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current NCR.
36. **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**
Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
